MEMORANDUM FOR ALL MISAWA PERSONNEL

SUBJECT: Authorization to utilize Misawa Air Base Airman's Dining Facilities

1. In accordance with AFI 34-239, Food Service Program Management, where such permission does not degrade our ability to serve our Essential Station Messing customers, the following categories are authorized to utilize the Misawa Air Base Airman's Dining Facilities:

- a. Active duty enlisted members may dine at the dining facility for any meal.
- b. First Sergeants, all E-9s, and Commanders (squadron and above), may use the dining facility for any meal to periodically determine the quality of food served.
- c. On-duty officers working/assigned in the controlled area of the flight line are authorized to utilize the Falcon Feeder Dining Facility only.
- d. Officers, DoD civilian employees on SOFA status and their family members are authorized to utilize the Grissom Dining Facility on federal holidays, Easter and the Air Force Birthday.
- e. Military retirees and immediate family members.
- f. TDY personnel whose orders authorize or direct the use of government dining facilities.
- g. Dependents of E-1 - E-4 personnel may use the dining facility for dinner on the weekends. Spouse and children of members in ranks E-1 - E-4 will pay discount rate (food cost without surcharge).
- h. Youth groups hosted by DoDDS for official sanctioned activities. These visits must be coordinated in advance with the food service superintendent.
- i. Dependents of deployed service members when participating in sponsored programs at the base dining facility such as AEF Passport.
