

## Changes to AFI 36-2306, Voluntary Education Program

1. Cumulative GPA (of all courses in students' Air Force education record) must be at least 2.0 once member has completed 15 SH for undergraduate coursework and at least 3.0 for graduate courses. Undergraduate students who have completed at least 15 SH through Mil TA and who do not maintain at least a 2.0 GPA will be denied further TA. Graduate students who do not maintain at least a 3.0 will be denied further TA. Students may fund courses personally or through their GI Bills to improve their GPA and request future Mil TA.

2. Clock/Contact hours for vocational programs (certificate and licenses) will be calculated as follows: 45 contact hours will be considered equivalent to one semester-credit. This will make a big difference in the amount of Mil TA authorized for vocational programs.

3. TA will only pay for non-degree oriented language courses that are on the DoD Strategic Language List.\*

\*Current list does not reflect any "Dominant in the Force Languages".

Those that are considered Prevalent/Dominant In the Force languages (deemed by the DoD as a surplus) will not be funded--EXCEPT for members assigned outside the continental U.S who take host country language courses and present valid orders.
